Summary — Projects ENOVATE and GR GATE each had a goal to enroll 275 randomly assigned participants and Launch Hampton Roads had a goal to enroll 200 randomly assigned participants. After random assignments, consortium partners collectively were to enroll 250 additional participants (ENOVATE and GR GATE each to enroll 100 additional participants and Launch Hampton Roads would enroll 50 additional participants).


- At the conclusion of random assignment, ENOVATE is 47% of goal; GR GATE is 39% of goal; and Launch Hampton Roads is 71% of goal.
- At the conclusion of non-random assignment, ENOVATE exceeded is goal of 100 additional participants by 55participants; GR GATE is 67% of goal; and Launch Hampton Roads exceeded its goal of 50 additional participants by 28 participants.
