Projects ENO VATE and GATE each had a goal to enroll 275 randomly assigned participants and Launch Hampton Roads had a goal to enroll 200 randomly assigned participants. As of February 1,2015 all participants are enrolled without going through the random assignment process.


At the conclusion of random assignment, ENO VATE is 47% of goal; GATE is 39% of goal; and Launch Hampton Roads is 71% of goal.


