What is the ESLA Program?

ESLA prepares and empowers jobseekers with barriers such as **low-income, legal history, and/or disabilities** to enter and maintain employment with the prospect of a career path and wage growth. Customized employment supports for qualified job seekers in Fairfax and Prince William counties may include:

- ✓ Employer outreach
- ✓ Career and job coaching
- ✓ Paid work experiences
- ✓ On-going customer support
- ✓ Job lead assistance
- ✓ Training
- ✓ Follow-up Incentive

Who's Eligible?

Fairfax or Prince William County residents who meet 200% of Federal poverty guidelines (see chart) and have at least one child under 18 years old.
