Career Services:

Offers assistance with:

- Resume review
- Assistance with job applications

Network Up:

A short-term mentoring program that matches a job seeker with a volunteer mentor in the same or similar field. Together, you identify career goals, establish a job search strategy, learn industry knowledge, and begin to develop and grow your professional networking connections.

Avenues to Career Training (ACT) — Healthcare:

A partnership between Britepaths and Fairfax County Department of Housing, Progress Center, ACT is an 8-week pre-employment program to prepare adults for certification programs in the healthcare field. The program provides introductions to general healthcare knowledge and medical terminology, career exploration, guest speakers, computer training, job readiness skills, and financial literacy.

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
